In 1999 the Power began with just two teams and a dream. In 2011 the Pittsburgh Power will be celebrating its 13th season and will field over 20 highly competitive teams. For eleven years the Power has been providing the opportunity for girls in western Pennsylvania to play at the highest level of tournament softball.

The program is 100% focused on the players. The organization concentrates on providing a positive and safe playing environment. The Power has its own indoor 24/7 facility for their players and teams to use, providing year round practice time. There are no paid staff, board members, or coaches ALL are volunteers. All managers and coaches are required to have their state child abuse clearances and a criminal background checks. Coaches, players, and parents are required sign a code of conduct statement.

The Power brings in the worlds best Olympic and professional players to work with our girls. In the past we have entertained in Dot Richardson, Jenny Finch, Natasha Whatley, Tairia Flowers and Cat Osterman. In May 2008 the organization brought in the entire United States Olympic team as part of their Bound for Beijing pre-Olympic tour.

But all this comes with a price. The player fee for 2011 season is \$730.00. While this may seem like a lot, compared to other organizations our fee can be hundreds less and even thousands of dollars less. Success like this can only continue with the help of sponsors.

Sponsors play a very important role and the Power organization and the individual players are seeking Sponsors for the 2011 season.
